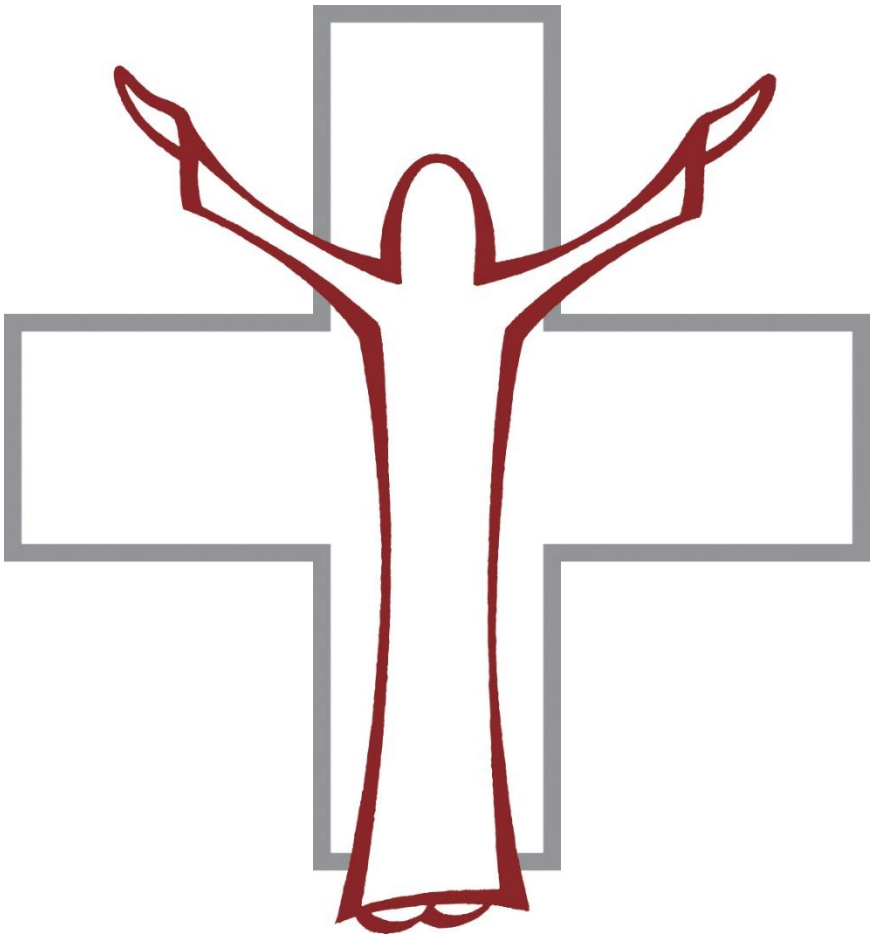

He is risen! He is risen, indeed! Welcome to this house of worship. The Festival of Easter is a celebration in the church for the resurrection of Christ, His proclamation of our righteousness, and His victory of sin’s most dreaded consequence - death.

THE RINGING OF THE BELLS

THE ANNOUNCEMENT

P: This is the day that the Lord has made.

C: We will rejoice and be glad in it.

P: Why are you looking among the dead for the One who is alive? He is arisen!

C: He is risen, indeed! Alleluia!

The congregation shall stand and face the narthex. As the processional cross passes them, worshipers shall turn and continue to focus their eyes and hearts on the cross

THE EASTER RESPONSE

P: Grace and peace to you from who is, and who was, and who is to come, from the Lord, Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth.

C: To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve His God and Father—to Him be glory and power forever and ever! Amen.

P: Christ is risen! Alleluia!

C: He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

P: And all the creatures of the earth shout:

C: Amen!

P: And all the saints and angels shout:

C: Amen!

P: And the people of the Lamb shout:

C: Amen and amen!

THE INVOCATION

P: In Baptism, your old sinful nature was buried with Christ when He died. When God the Father brought Him back to life again, you were given His wonderful new life to enjoy. To remind ourselves of what happened at our Baptism we speak the words that were spoken at our Baptism.

C: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

THE CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

C: But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination

P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

P: In the mercy of almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for us, and for His sake God forgives us all our sins. To those who believe in Jesus Christ He gives the power to become the children of God and bestows on them the Holy Spirit. May the Lord, who has begun this good work in us, bring it to completion in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

C: Amen.

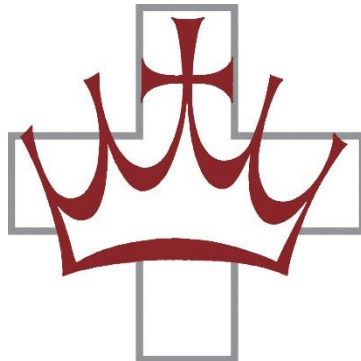
