P: *The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.*

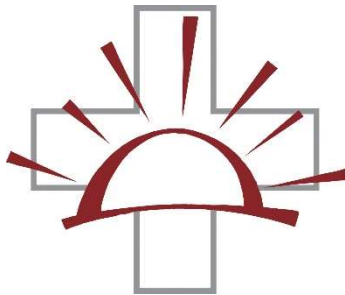
