The application is a two-step process.

First, reserve your place in line by completing a brief online form. This step will determine your place in line for the firstcome, first-served scholarships.

After reserving your place in line, families will be emailed a unique link and use their reservation code to complete the full application.

Please remember if you are applying for financial aid from Trinity Lutheran School, this process must be complete first.
