STRATEGIC PLAN SPOTLIGHT

In 2016, Trinity Lutheran Church and School adopted a Strategic Plan to guide its efforts and bring about improvements across all areas of ministry. In these weekly spotlights, we are featuring areas of the Strategic Plan that have been completed or are currently in development.

Under the focus area, Encourage Members to be Spiritually-Mature, one of the strategies is to develop and implement a plan for increased retention of our youth, Confirmands, and young adults. In 2014, prior to the Strategic Plan creation, a plan was developed to acknowledge our youth by sending birthday, Baptismal birthday, Confirmation, and graduation cards beginning in their 7th grade year and ending as they graduate from high school. Individuals and groups within the congregation have been diligently sending out these cards and making connections with our youth since that time. Currently 86 students are receiving these cards. The first group of students in this program will graduate from high school in the spring. The efficacy of the program will be evaluated, and improvements will be made as necessary.

WE'RE LEARNING A NEW HYMN! The sermon hymn for our Sunday morning worship provides an opportunity to experience a new hymn. "Lo, He Comes, With Clouds Descending" was written by Charles Wesley (1707-1788), a founder of the Methodist Church. Wesley was the author of over 6000 hymns, many of which are still popular today. Among Trinity's favorites are "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing" and "Love, Divine, All Loves Excelling." A listing of other hymns in our hymnal written by Wesley can be found on page 1002. The text of "Lo, He Comes, With Clouds Descending" was inspired by the book of Revelation and describes the majesty and splendor of the Second Coming of Christ. How fitting it is to mark this Last Sunday of the Church Year with ringing hymns of praise. Come, Lord Jesus.
