SUNDAY SCHOOL AND WEEKLY BIBLE STUDIES

THIS WEEK IN SUNDAY SCHOOL: Today in Sunday School we studied the calling of Jesus' first disciples with "Jesus Calls Philip and Nathanael." Access to heaven is given to all who believe through Jesus. You might discuss, "How did Philip and Nathanael know that Jesus was the Christ? How do we learn that Jesus is the Christ?"

SUNDAY MORNING ADULT BIBLE CLASSES:
